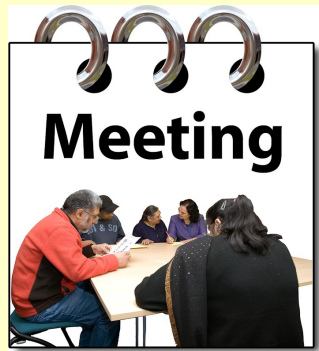

We will have four Co-Chairs

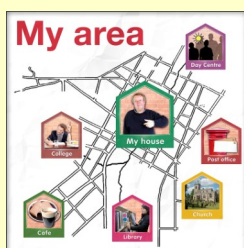

Jo Findlay will help and will come to the meetings when Val can't.

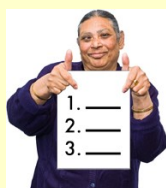


ACTION!

The group said that they would like the meetings to be in the same place each time and that it should be easy to get to for everyone.

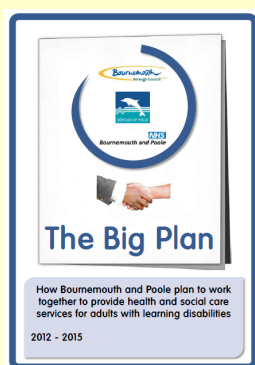
Val will check with People First Dorset and if they agree we will look for somewhere in Wimborne

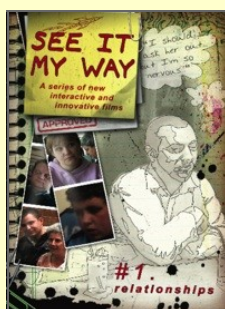

Lorraine Bailey told us that the last person from campus is about to move.

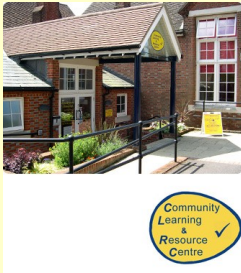
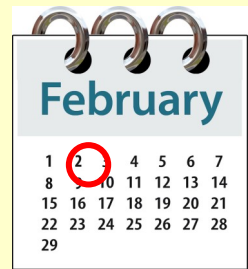

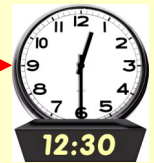
