

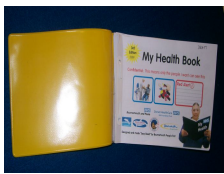
Health Day Action Plan

Val Cope and Jo Findlay will do this by March 2011

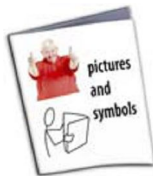


We will make sure that staff who support people with learning disabilities to keep healthy have training in how to do this

Chris Pacey will make sure this happens in Community Teams



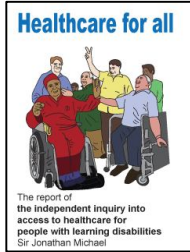
Fenella Barnes will make sure that people who work in Doctors surgeries know about carers needs

Doctors receptionists will be given training on how to help people with learning disabilities when they go to see their doctor



We want Dorset People First to check doctor's surgeries to see how they are doing



We will ask for money from NHS Dorset for this



We will give information and advice to dentists about how they can help people with learning disabilities look after their teeth

We will tell dentists about how the yellow books can be used to help plan for visits to the dentist

The hospital champions in Dorset County Hospital will make sure that all staff have information to help them to look after people with learning disabilities

This information will also be used in the Community Hospitals



The signs in Dorset County Hospital need to be clear

Hospital champions will have training in how to look after people with a learning disability when they are patients



Training will also be given to hospital staff when they have safeguarding training and to new staff when they start work
