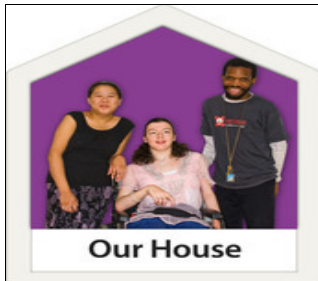
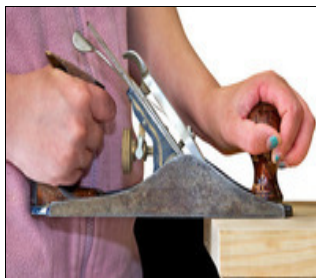


Joint Commissioning Strategy Update Easy to Read Version

There are 225 people with a learning disability who have a Personal Budget.

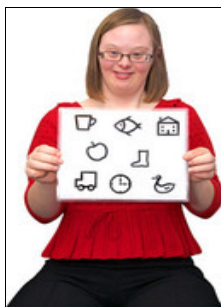
